
Please follow these directions to learn methods for copy and paste of text and links on your iPad.

Copy and Paste on an iPad is very easy. Though there are some differences you should know about. It is all about content.

First is how to copy a URL or weblink.


We are going to use the SRC Reading Counts App as an example.

For Students...




Open "App Portal". Scroll down to "Reading Counts App".

Install and Select "OK". SRC App will load.






Press and hold on URL in email or enclosed link and the URL Options box opens.


Select "Copy".

This copies URL in iPad temporary memory and is stored until you use copy feature again or iPad is turned off or shutdown. Now, we are going to Paste this URL in our Reading Counts App settings

Open "Settings"




Scroll down to "SRC" (Reading Counts App)



On right, you will notice a Site ID box. This is where we will paste our copied URL

Press finger in empty box and the Paste option will pop up.


Enter your Scholastic hosted Site ID



Practice: Copy and paste this line in the Notes App




Press and hold on text in email and the Copy Options box opens.

Notice the blue circles. These allow you to change your selection to add more text or less.

Select the text from above and copy.

You can also pinch out to make text larger and easier to select.
